SALE OF TOBACCO

The Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) invites offers to purchase 721,055 pounds of 2000 and 2001 Crop of CCC-owned Fire-Cured Type 22 tobacco, 1,202,301 pounds of 2000 and 2001 crop of CCC-owned Fire-Cured Type 23 tobacco, 143,735 pounds of 2004 crop of CCC-owned Fire-Cured Type 21 tobacco and 134,731 pounds of 2004 crop of CCC-owned Air-Cured Type 36 tobacco in accordance with the terms and conditions of Announcement SMAC. The tobacco will be sold as is/where is basis with no minimum bid price. CCC will not pay outage charges.

Those persons who may bid with respect to the tobacco offered under this Invitation No. 29 are those persons subject to the payment of the Tobacco Transition Payment Program (TTPP) assessment as determined under 7 CFR 1463.6. Generally, these persons are required to have a permit issued by the Department of the Treasury in order to manufacture or import tobacco products. CCC will, if bids are not accepted on a lot, re-offer to all parties at a later date.

Catalogs listing various lots of CCC-owned tobacco available for sale are shown in Exhibits A, B, C & D.

Offers must be submitted per lot in its entirety. Each lot will be analyzed independently. No offer on a lot can be contingent upon the acceptance of another lot. Offers cannot be submitted contingent upon maximum quantities. Any offer submitted is subject to acceptance.

Offers and any modification or withdrawal of offers must be received in the Kansas City Commodity Office by 10:00 a.m., CT, May 16, 2005.

Successful Bidders will be notified of acceptance by telephone by 5:00 p.m., CT, May 19, 2005, subsequently followed by written confirmation.

For purposes of this Invitation only, all references to "miscellaneous agricultural commodities" in Announcement SMAC are hereby changed to read "tobacco" and the following changes to the Announcement apply:

3. SUBMISSION OF OFFERS

A. How to Submit Offers

- (1) Offers must be submitted by regular mail, express mail, facsimile, or hand delivered. Reproductions of the offer form are acceptable. Offers that are hand delivered or submitted by mail must include an original signature.

Title and risk of loss will transfer from CCC to the contractor by transmission of delivery notification (wire release) to the tobacco associations upon receipt of payment for the tobacco awarded.

CCC will pay storage through the end of the month after the date of wire release. Storage after that date will be for the account of the buyer.
